

Web Page Considerations - What to include

1. `<title></title>`

Change the title of your webpage: "My Favourite..."

2. `<body></body>`

Add information about your topic between these tags including:

- **Headings**

Include at least **2** different sized headings on your webpage

`<h1>`This is the LARGEST Heading`</h1>`

`<h6>`This is the SMALLEST Heading`</h6>`

- **Paragraphs**

`<p>`Order your information into **3** paragraphs`</p>`

`<p>`Paragraph 1`</p>`

`<p>`Paragraph 2`</p>`

`<p>`Paragraph 3`</p>`

- **Images**

Include at least **2** images of your chosen topic

- **Line Break**

Organise the information on your webpage by using at least **1** horizontal rule
